WLSC 2020 COVID-19 OPERATING PROCEDURES

In order for the pool to open this season, Prince George's County has mandated that we implement the following changes which **MUST** occur without exception.

- Walkway through the office space has been closed. Members and guests must enter and exit through bathhouses. Office area will remain sanitized for staff and first aid.
- When members sign in, they will have to answer a few questions in regard to their health and/or potential exposure to COVID-19 within the past 14 days. If they or anyone in their party is/has been sick or has had contact with a confirmed COVID-19 case, they will be asked to leave the pool grounds and it will be documented in Pool Dues.
- Six foot markers will be placed in strategic areas as reminders of social distancing.
- Members will be asked to adhere to social distancing on the grounds and in the pool.
- Members and guests may be restricted to a 2 hour limit if the state/county set requirements for capacity limits. If capacity is set at 75 or less there will be a limit of 2 guests per membership.
- Members will be expected to use proper cough etiquette and hand hygiene.
- Members will be asked to dispose of all trash in the proper receptacles.
- Members will be asked to turn loungers and chairs on their side when leaving so guards and other members know they need disinfecting.
- Picnic tables have painted markers to place on tables when members are finished so guards and members know they need disinfecting.
- There will be hand sanitizing stations available for members near the bathhouses.

- The office phone will not be available for member use. However, a staff member can place a call in an emergency for a member.
- Parties or events may be prohibited based on state and/or county mandates.
- If a member or guest has been to the pool and becomes diagnosed with COVID-19, they will be expected to notify the board of directors immediately so proper actions can be taken to ensure the well-being of staff and members.
- If deemed appropriate, a pool employee will take the temperature of a member or guest upon entry. If a member or guest exhibits a fever as defined by the CDC as a temperature over 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit, they will not be permitted to enter pool grounds.
- At 2:50pm and 5:50pm a warning bell will be rung as a reminder to members and guests that bathhouses will be closed for cleaning in 10 minutes.
- Bathhouses will simultaneously be closed for approximately 15 minutes for disinfecting daily at 3 pm and 6 pm. Entrances and exits will be closed during that time. In the event of an emergency, other entrances and exits will be used. While bathrooms are being cleaned, members and guests are not permitted to use them or enter them.
- As per existing WLSC policy, we ask for your continued respect of our staff during this unprecedented time as they work to keep our community safe and healthy.

By signing this agreement, you acknowledge the above operating procedures that have been implemented. You agree that you and all members of your household and guests will abide by these operating procedures. Failure to abide by the WLSC 2020 COVID-19 OPERATING PROCEDURES will result in removal from the grounds for the remainder of the day. Multiple offenses may result in membership suspension.
